While SofTest-M is our flagship tool for accessibility, our roadmap has committed to making our Mac and PC versions accessible by early 2017. In addition, faculty members have robust options for exporting exams built in the platform onto paper if needed.

Section 508 of the United States Rehabilitation Act outlines the requirements for making web sites accessible to individuals with disabilities. These standards detail how different components of web sites need to be designed to make the web content accessible. Under Section 508, the U.S. federal government has 16 standards that are used to define web accessibility, the attached Voluntary Product Accessibility Template (VPAT) document tells institutions how SofTest-M applies these standards.

ExamSoft is dedicated to evolving the platform as new accessibility requirements and technologies arise, and have resources internally tasked with the research and development of this functionality.
